

Cookies policy

What are Cookies?

For correct navigation through this website and to guarantee user access to all content advertised by PECUNIA CARDS EDE, SL, free of errors, physical files of personal information hosted on the user's own terminal are used, commonly known as cookies. navigation. Cookies allow us to remember preferences and recognize users on subsequent visits to the site, as well as to correctly display certain sections of the website.

If you do not expressly accept its installation, we will consider that you reject its use. The user has the possibility, at any time, to configure their browser in order to check the cookies used, enable and disable existing cookie files, check the persistence and expiration date, as well as adapt the warning configuration to their needs. navigation blocking. This website uses both its own and third-party cookies.

Duty to inform and obtain consent in relation to the use of cookies

In accordance with the provisions of current legislation, any website that uses cookies must provide clear and complete information about their purpose, and it is mandatory to obtain the express consent of users before downloading them, except in relation to called "excepted cookies" for which it is NOT necessary to obtain consent. Excepted cookies include:

- **Technical cookies:** these are those that allow the user to navigate through a web page, platform or application and use the different options or services that exist there, such as, for example, controlling traffic and data communication, identifying the session, access restricted access parts, remember the elements that make up an order, carry out the purchase process of an order, make a request for registration or participation in an event, use security elements during navigation, store content for dissemination of videos or sound or share content through social networks. Also included in this category are cookies that allow obtaining information for effective management of advertising design from a strictly technical point of view.
- **Personalization cookies:** these are those that allow the user to access the service with some general characteristics predefined based on a series of criteria on the user's terminal, such as the language, the type of browser through which the user accesses the service. , the locale from where you access the service, etc. If it is the user themselves who chooses these characteristics (for example, if they select the language of a website, the currency they wish to use in transactions...), it will not

be necessary to obtain consent to install said cookies as it is considered a service expressly requested by the user, as long as the cookies serve exclusively the selected purpose.

The use of the rest of the cookies - that is, those not excepted - implies the duty to inform and obtain the express consent of the user prior to downloading them .

Cookies NOT excepted

Cookies can be classified according to different criteria. From a legal point of view, and as explained in the previous section, there are excepted and non-excepted cookies.

Other classification criteria concern the type of cookie management (own or third-party), activation time (session cookies and permanent cookies) or type of purpose.

The classification of non-excepted cookies based on purpose is especially relevant. From this point of view, non-excepted cookies can be:

- **Analytical cookies:** These are those that, whether processed by the owner of the site or by third parties, allow the person responsible to measure user activity on the website for statistical purposes.
- **Behavioral advertising cookies:** These are those that allow the most efficient possible management of the advertising spaces that, where appropriate, the editor has included in a web page, application or platform from which the requested service is provided. These cookies store information on user behavior obtained through continuous observation of their browsing habits, which allows the development of a specific profile to display advertising based on it.
- **Plug-in cookies:** The cookies used by plug-ins from external content providers are necessary so that the user can access previously requested content or services that are provided by third-party providers such as viewing videos hosted on YouTube , geographic locations on Google Maps , connection with social networks, etc. These cookies are governed by the provisions of the respective cookie policies of the external providers.

How can I enable, disable or block cookies?

- Google Chrome: Tools > Settings > Show advanced options > content settings > Cookies > Block site data and third-party cookies
- Mozilla Firefox: Tools > Options > Privacy > History > Use custom settings for history (uncheck all boxes)
- Internet Explorer: Tools > Internet Options > Privacy > Settings for the Internet zone (raise the navigation bar to Block all cookies)
- Safari: Edit > Preferences > Privacy > Block cookies (select “always”)
- Opera 19: Menu > Settings Privacy and security > Cookies section (select Block third-party cookies and site data)
- Microsoft Edge: Open Microsoft Edge, then select Settings and more > Settings > Site permissions. Select Cookies and site data.

The user can revoke their consent to the use of cookies in their browser through the instructions above.
